Dental Services




- 👤 **Dental services are covered in the Partnership for Hope Waiver through the Division of Developmental Disabilities.**
- 👤 **The Partnership for Hope (PFH) Waiver is a county-based home and community-based waiver. This waiver was developed as a result of a partnership of the Missouri Association for County Boards for Developmental Disability Services, the Division of Developmental Disabilities, and the MO HealthNet Division.**



Dental Services (continued)

- 🕒 Dental services in the PfH waiver are only covered for individuals age 21 and over.
- 🕒 Children *under* 21 years of age and participants in a category of assistance for pregnant women, the blind, or vendor nursing facility residents are eligible for the complete dental benefit through MO HealthNet.
- 🕒 MO HealthNet also covers a specific list of dental services for adults in other categories of assistance. These services, along with their descriptions, requirements, and limitations can be found in the MO HealthNet Dental Provider Manual at:

Dental Services (continued)

-  Dental services covered in the PfH waiver include:
- Topical fluoride applications;
 - Therapeutic dental treatment, such as pulp therapy for permanent teeth; and
 - Limited provision of removable prostheses when masticatory function is impaired, when an existing prosthesis is unserviceable.

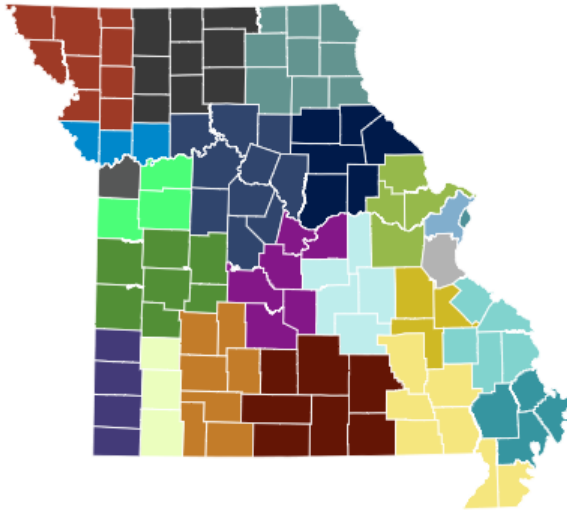
