The Missouri Coalition for Oral Health (MCOH) invites abstracts for Poster Presentations for the 2020 Oral Health Policy Conference – *Show Me Access to Health*.

Research Poster Presentations:

The Coalition is interested in issues relevant to population oral health, dental public health and oral health policy. These may address scientific research, community-based interventions, epidemiology of oral diseases, oral health disparities, oral health policy, oral health promotion and program evaluation.

Community Organization Presentations:

The Coalition invites applications for posters presenting on medical/dental integration, expanding access to oral health services, clinic efficiency models, and new/innovative oral health care delivery systems, i.e. teledentistry. Posters of this nature can be tailored to tell the story of a project and/or systems change within an individual clinic or organization.

Conference participants include public health professionals, educators, health care professionals, dental professionals, consumers, health clinic staff, head start, community action agencies, mental health professionals, students, community health workers, foundation staff, rural health clinics, community agencies, advocates, agencies serving children and youth, agencies serving people with disabilities, agencies serving seniors, and anyone interested in improving the oral health of Missouri.

Participants will get familiar with your poster presentation which will be available in the conference's venue during the entire length of the program. Presenters will have an opportunity to discuss and explain their project in direct contact to the audience.

Abstracts for poster presentations can be submitted via e-mail and must be received by February 28, 2020. Complete the application attached to this notice and e-mail applications to info@oralhealthmissouri.org. Please contact the Coalition with questions - info@oralhealthmissouri.org.

Please note:

- Only abstracts submitted via e-mail are accepted, no exceptions.
- Authors may be listed on multiple abstracts, but an individual can present only one (1) poster presentation.
- No more than two (2) individuals author/co-author can present the poster presentation at the conference.
- Funding sources must be identified.
- Posters will be displayed using Command strips. Weight of poster display must not exceed five (5) pounds.
- Presenters ***must have permission*** to present data/abstract when it is submitted for consideration,
- **Poster Presenters selected to present at the 2020 Oral Health Policy Conference must register and pay the applicable registration fee. Poster Presenters must be present for both days of the conference. Poster viewing times will be during scheduled conference breaks.**

- Poster Presenters selected to present will be required to complete a Conflict of Interest form.
- Poster Presenters are responsible for delivering their poster to the conference registration desk on Thursday, March 5, 2020, at the conference hotel by 9:30 a.m. and having their poster set up by 10:30 a.m. Poster presenters are responsible for removing their poster and materials on Friday, March 6, 2020 after noon. Posters and materials left on display at the completion of the conference will be discarded.

Poster Presentation Specifications

Structure and Design

- Poster boards may be 42 x 42 inches, 42 x 48 inches or 42 x 52 inches.
- The text should be large enough to be read easily from 4-6 feet away.
- Use font size proportional to importance, such as:
 - Largest font size - Title
 - Next largest font size - Section Headings
 - Medium font size - Supporting Material
- Try to have a high contrast between background and text.
- Choose a typeface that is simple and bold enough to be legible.
- Graphs and photos need to be large enough to be seen clearly at 4-6 feet away.
- All posters are subject to review prior to display.

Content and Topics

- Research project
- Practice change
- Program proposal
- Work / professional practice projects
- Medical/Dental integration projects
- Practice efficiency projects
- Expanding access to dental care projects
- New/Innovative care delivery models, i.e. teledentistry

Poster Display Focus

- Title - brief, simple, catchy and emphasizing the key message of the study
- Introduction - short and legible
- Hypothesis or Objective
- Abstract (if research based)
- Methodology
- Results or Outcomes
- Summary of Conclusions
- References
