Q6 As a member of the Policy Committee, how would you describe the committee's process over the last year, to create and update MCOH's policy agenda:

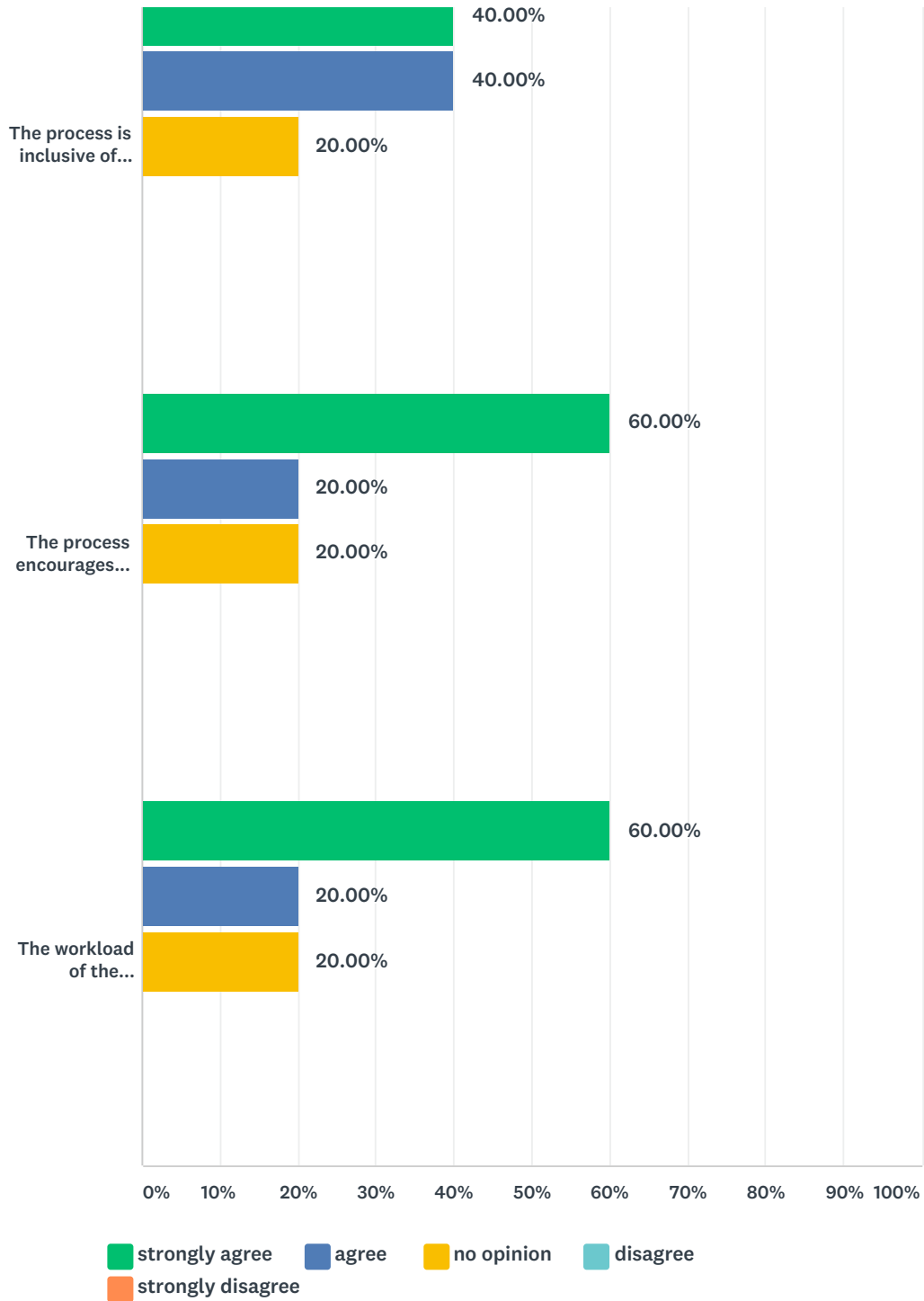

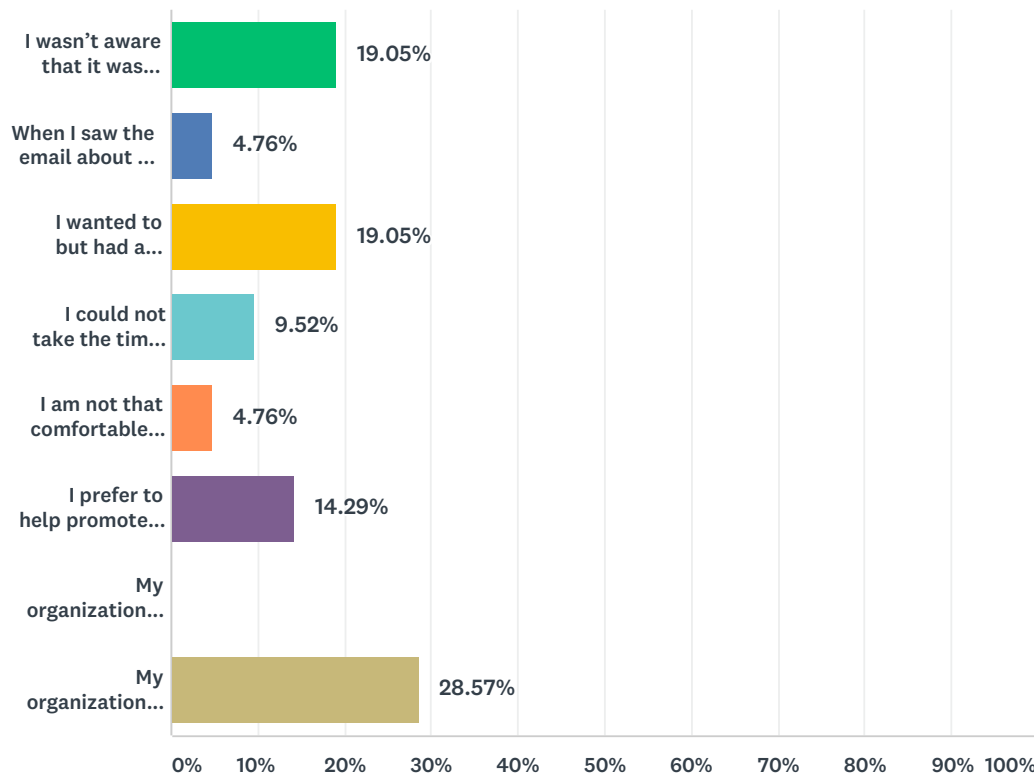

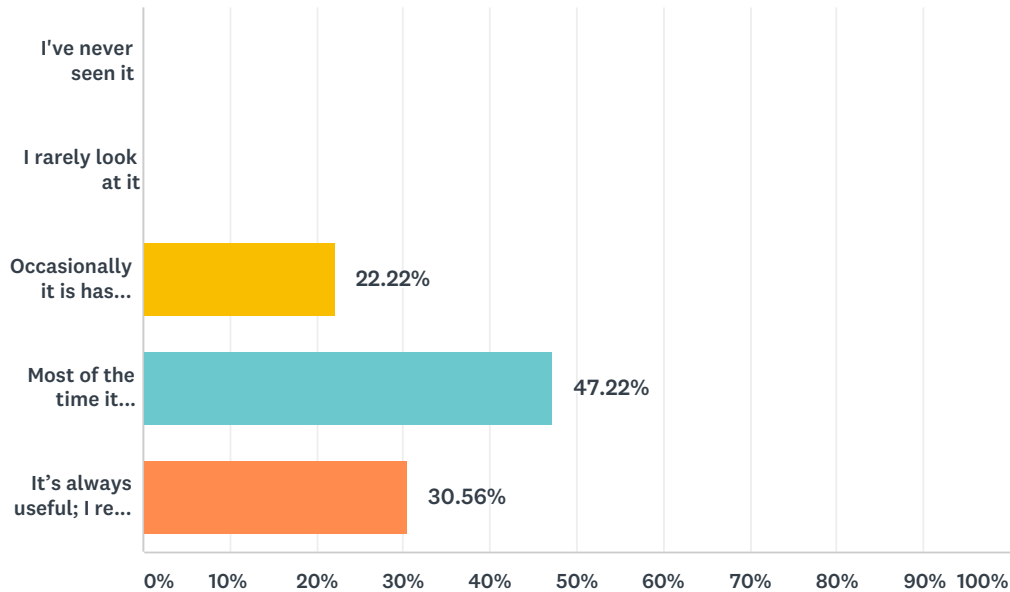

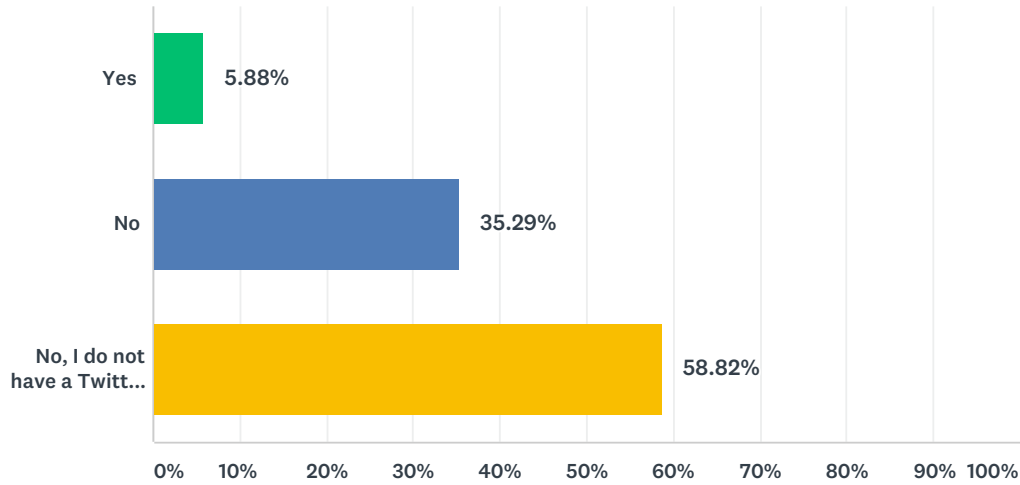

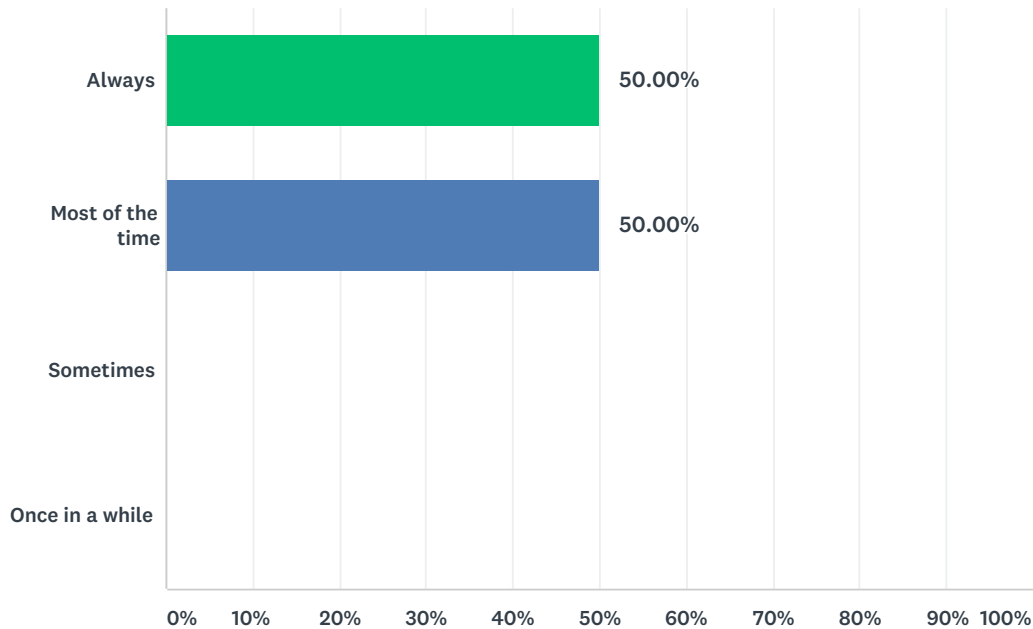

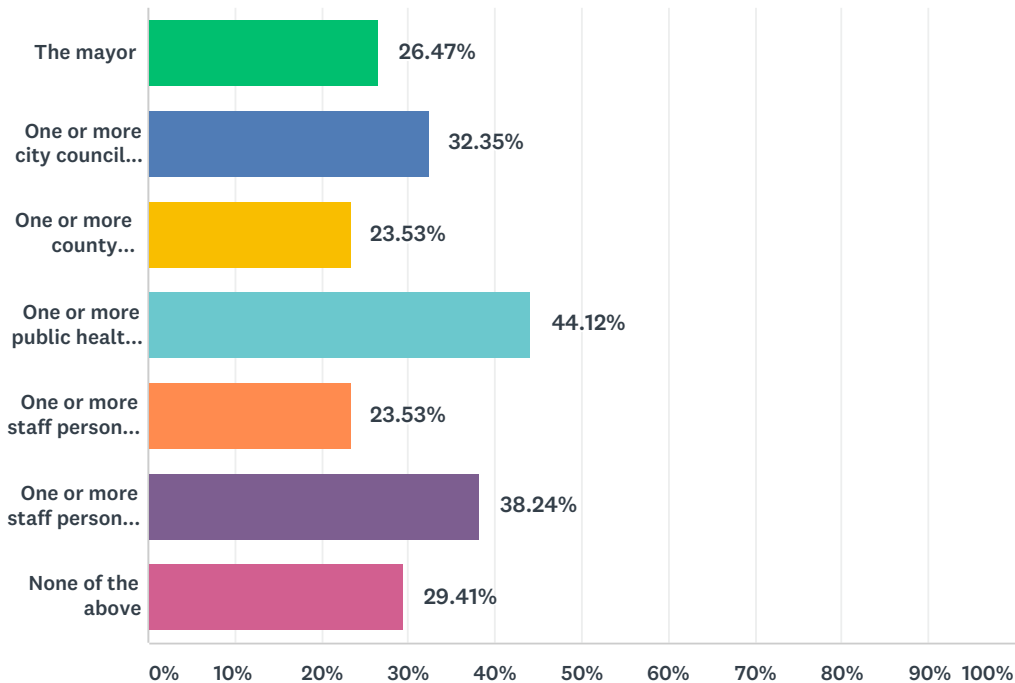

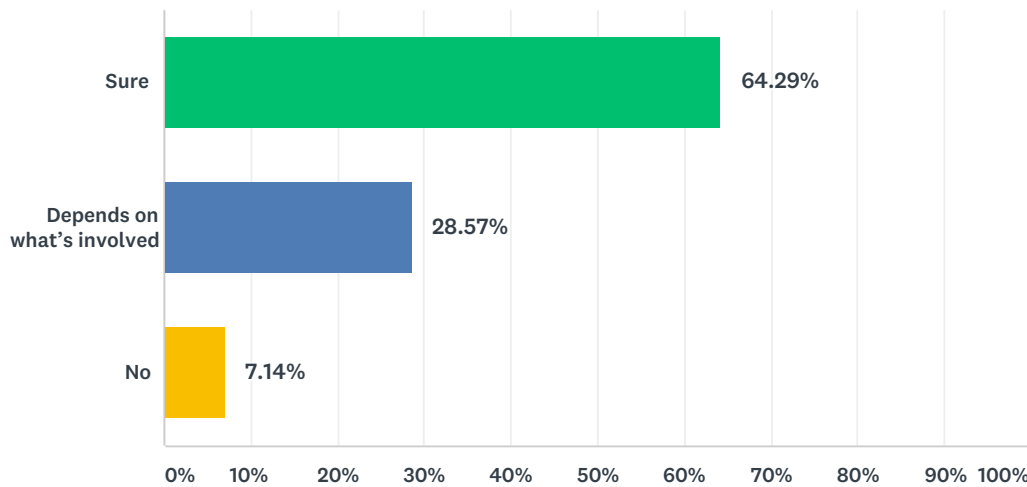

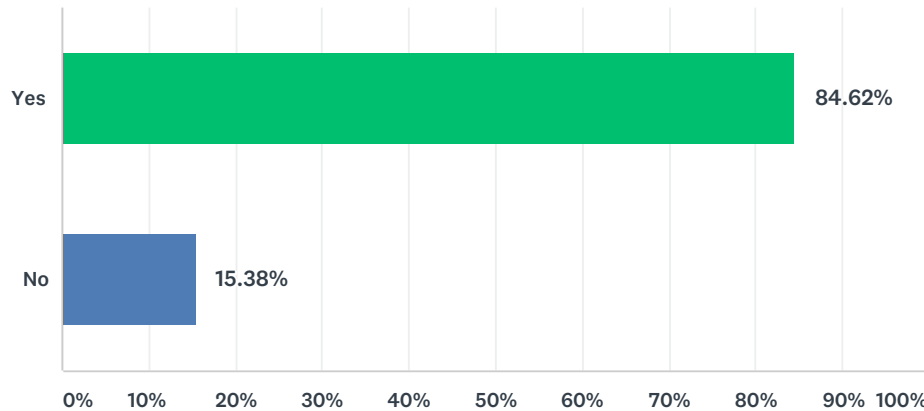

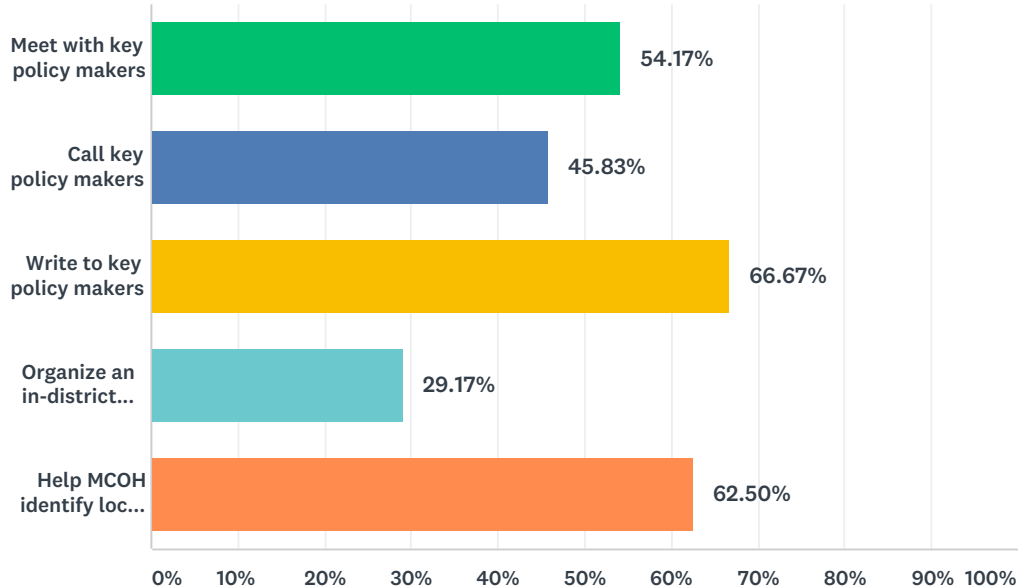
