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Assessment Tools Used

PRAPARE Form

(Protocol for Responding to Assessing
Patients Assets, Risks, and Experiences)



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We focus on the Social Determinants of Health for
all of our patients and clients.



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We fill out a PRAPARE form annually on all of our patients and enter the information into our Electronic Medical Record (ECW).



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By entering the information into ECW the data can then be pulled into Azara DRVS by our organization and the Missouri Primary Care Association.

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HCC has a 7,500 square foot warehouse located in Lexington that has a loading dock where we glean items that would otherwise go into the landfill.



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I don't mean trash, I mean laundry detergent, body wash, shampoo, conditioner, lotion, beds, mattresses, durable medical equipment, etc. Things that can't be purchased with food stamps.



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Everything that comes into our Warehouse is free
and everything that goes out is free. Your
organization must be a Network Member of HCC to
access the warehouse.

Laundry PODS over 6,000 lbs.	30 refrigerators
Various cleaning supplies 12,000 lbs.	22 new window ac units
1,500 individual pieces of Feminine Hygiene products	30 chairs/recliners
80 Canes (single and 4 legged support canes)	40 kitchen tables/chairs
60 Nebulizers (adult and child)	2500 lbs. first aid supplies

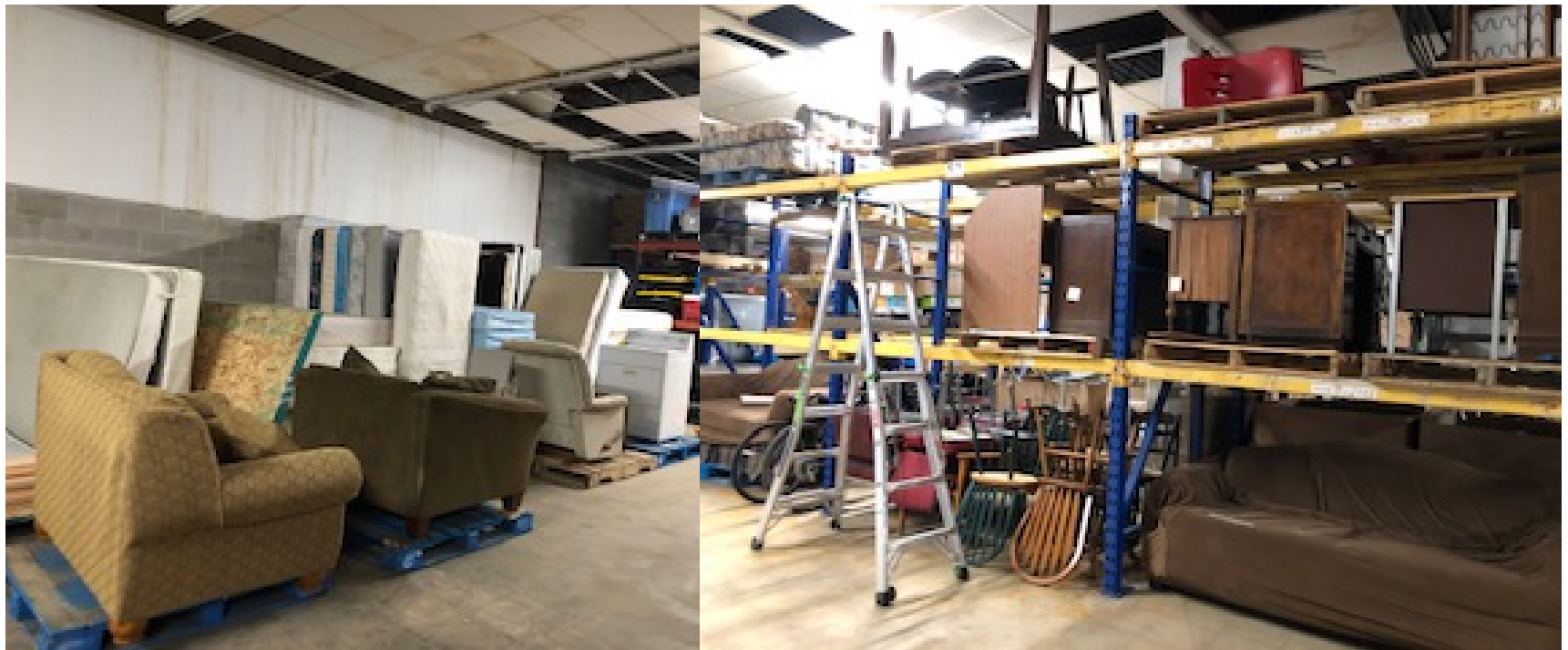
