Prepare for the new rules coming in 2027

Help protect your healthcare coverage

New rules are coming in January 2027 for people with MO HealthNet (Missouri Medicaid). The best way to prepare is to follow these 3 tips:

1 - Check your contact information

Make sure your address, email, and household information are up-to-date with the Family Support Division (FSD):

- Check it online at my.mo.gov/fsdbenefits
- Or call FSD at 855-373-4636



2 - Learn your MO HealthNet renewal date

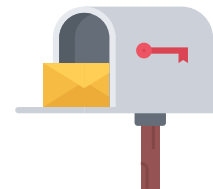
When you visit my.mo.gov/fsdbenefits or call FSD, also find out what your MO HealthNet renewal date is, and:

- Mark it on your calendar
- Be ready to provide any information FSD asks for

3 - Open your mail from FSD

Watch your mailbox for any mail from the Missouri Family Support Division (FSD) or the Department of Social Services (DSS), and:

- Open and read mail from them to see what you need to do, and when
- Reply quickly if they need information from you



If your MO HealthNet coverage ends, contact a health center, hospital, FSD, or a trained assister right away. You may still qualify.
